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## Pakistan is doing 'balle-balle': PM

**JAMMU AND KASHMIR ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS**

Training his guns on the alliance partners-- Congress and the National Conference, Prime Minister Narendra Modi Thursday launched a fierce attack saying that Pakistan is doing 'balle-balle' over their manifesto for the assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir.

Addressing an impressive poll rally after conducting a road show in the Katra township, base camp of Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine, PM Modi said, "Nobody is giving them (Congress and National Conference) any importance here. But in Pakistan, inki balle balle ho rahi hai (they are being celebrated)."

Modi also accused the alliance partners of aligning with Pakistan's interests. The Prime Minister's remarks follow Pakistan's Defence Minister Khawaja Asif's statement in an interview in which he said that Pakistan and the NC-Congress alliance were on the same page on the restoration of Article 370.

He said that Pakistan has itself exposed the Congress and the National Conference. He went on to say that the BJP government will not allow the implementation of Pakistan's agenda in Jammu and Kashmir.

"Pakistan itself has exposed the Congress and the National Conference. They wanted to implement Pakistan's agenda here... We will not allow the implementation of Pakistan's agenda in Jammu and Kashmir. No power in the world can bring back Article 370 in Jammu and Kashmir".

PM Modi also sounded a note of caution saying that a vote for Congress would lead to the reinstatement of Article 370, which he said would pave the way for violence to return to the Valley.

"Every vote given to Congress will implement the manifesto of PDP and NC. PM Modi said that the upcoming elections will be a turning point for the region, framing the choice as one that will define the future of Jammu and Kashmir. This election is about choosing Jammu and Kashmir's future," PM Modi said.

Addressing another rally earlier inside the fortified Sher-i-Kashmir stadium in Srinagar PM Modi praised the high voter turnout in the first phase stating that it represents a rejection of parties that 'sympathise with stone pelters and terrorists'.

## Hezbollah fires new barrage into northern Israel

Hezbollah fired a new barrage into northern Israel on Thursday, continuing its drumbeat of exchanges with the Israeli military as fears of a greater war rise after hundreds of electronic devices exploded in Lebanon, killing at least 32 people and wounding more than 3,000 others.

The device explosions appeared to be the culmination of a monthslong operation by Israel to target as many Hezbollah members as possible all at once. Over two days, paggers and walkie-talkies used by Hezbollah detonated, wounding and even crippling some fighters, but also maiming civilians connected to the group's social branches and killing at least two children. It was unclear how the attack fit into warnings by Israeli leaders in recent weeks that they could launch a stepped-up military operation against Hezbollah, Lebanon's strongest armed force. The Israeli government has called it a war aim to end the Iranian-backed group's crossborder fire in order to allow tens of thousands of Israelis to return to homes near the border.

## India takes strong objection to US court's summons over Pannun's suit

Taking strong objection to a US court's summons to the Indian government over Khalistani terrorist Gurbatwant Singh Pannun's civil suit alleging a plot to murder him, Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri on Thursday termed it as "unwarranted" and "unsubstantiated imputations."

The US District Court for Southern District of New York named the Government of India, National Security Advisor Ajit Doval (NSA) and former R&AW chief Samant Goel, in the summons.

Foreign Secretary Misri said, "As we've said earlier, these are completely unwarranted and unsubstantiated imputations. Now that this particular case has been lodged, it doesn't change our views about the underlying situation. I would only invite your attention to the person behind this particular case whose antecedents are well known."

"I would also underline the fact that the organisation so-called that this person represents is an unlawful organisation, has been declared as such under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act of 1967 and it has been done so on account of its involvement in anti-national and subversive activities aimed at disrupting the sovereignty and territorial integrity of India," he added.

Pannun heads the radical Sikhs for Justice and is known to put out incendiary speeches and threats against Indian leaders and institutions. New Delhi designated him a terrorist in 2020.



the Government of India, National Security Advisor Ajit Doval, former R&AW chief Samant Goel, in the summons. The summons also named Indian businessman Nikhil Gupta and R&AW agent Vikram Yadav and seeks a reply within 21 days.

In November, the UK newspaper Financial Times reported that the US had thwarted a plot to kill Pannun, who holds dual citizenship in the US and Canada. Officials in the Joe Biden administration later confirmed this.

In its first response, the External Affairs Ministry had said it is a "matter of concern" and stressed that India has launched a high-level probe.

"As regards the case against an individual that has been filed in a US court, allegedly linking him to an Indian official, this is a matter of concern. We have said that this is also contrary to government policy," then MEA spokesperson Arindam Bagchi had said.

## FATF releases mutual evaluation report on India

Global anti-money laundering and terror financing body FATF on Thursday launched its much-awaited mutual evaluation report on India, saying the country's systems were "effective" but "major improvements" were required to strengthen prosecution in these cases.



watchdog FATF has given high rating to India on parameters, including financial intelligence, anti money laundering and terror financing risks, as well as disclosure of beneficial ownership. Of the recommendations made by FATF, fast tracking trials in terror financing and money laundering cases is important. Rest of the recommendations are ancillary in nature, Agarwal said.

terror financing cases. It said improvements in the system were also required to protect the non-profit sector from terror abuse. "India's main sources of money laundering originate from within, from illegal activities committed within country," it said, adding the country faced "disparate" range of terror threats, most significantly from ISIL (Islamic State or ISIS) or AQ-linked groups (Al Qaeda) active in and around Jammu and Kashmir. The report analyses the level of compliance with the FATF 40 Recommendations and the level of effectiveness of India's AML/CFT system, and provides recommendations on how the system can be strengthened.

The income tax department has used multiple data points to identify "at risk" NPOs and there is ongoing engagement with NPOs to sensitise them so that they are not used as a medium for financing terror, Agarwal said. "India has no low rating (by FATF) on any parameter... It is either high rating or medium rating," Agarwal added.

## Drunken college goers meet mishap

Two Delhi University students were grievously injured while three received minor injuries when their speeding SUV crashed into a guardrail that pierced through the middle of the vehicle near Rajghat in north Delhi on early Thursday. According to police, the black coloured Hyundai Venue car had five occupants, all students of Delhi University colleges, who were returning from a birthday party at a pub in neighbouring Gurugram. Prima facie, it appears that the car was being driven at a high speed and the driver lost control leading to the crash, police said, adding that the incident occurred on the stretch of road from Shanti Van to Geeta Colony. "The car was going from Shanti Van Red light towards

Geeta Colony, when it reached at ISBT Slip road at around 05.52 am where it collided with the divider," DCP North Manoj Kumar Meena said.

19 year old Ashwani Mishra, who was driving the car, is a first-year student at Delhi University's Dyal Singh College and hailed from Uttar Pradesh's Etawah. He had rented the car for a night to celebrate his birthday. "On Thursday, a call was received of an accident on the road from Shanti Van to Geeta Colony. It was subsequently found that one Ashwani Mishra to celebrate his birthday, along with his friends 19 years old Ashwani Pandey, who was a first year student at Deshbandhu College, and 20 year old Keshav, second year student at Dyal Singh College, rented a Hyundai Venue for the night at Rs 1500 from Shadipur," he said.

## 21 houses set ablaze in Bihar, probe underway

Twenty-one houses were set on fire in Bihar's Nawada district near the Capital city Patna. Preliminary investigation suggested that a land dispute could be the cause behind the incident that happened in Manjhi Tola in Mufassil police station area on Wednesday late evening. Nawada District Magistrate Ashutosh Kumar Verma said the district police has arrested 15 people for allegedly torching the houses. Verma said approximately 21 houses, some of which were semi-pucca, were burned by a group in Manjhi Tola. He added that senior administrative and police officials on-site will provide a report detailing the exact number of damaged houses. A police officer said shots were also fired in the air when the houses were being torched. Investigations have revealed that out of a total of 34 houses that were set on fire, 21 were completely destroyed and 13 were damaged partially. A Special Investigation Team (SIT) has been formed to investigate further, and searches are ongoing to apprehend the remaining

suspects. "We are providing relief materials, including food packets and drinking water, to those displaced. Temporary tents have been set up for the victims," he noted. The DM refuted claims that cattle were charred, saying, "No evidence has been found to support that." Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar condemned the torching of 34 houses, mostly belonging to SC/ST communities, in Nawada district and asked the Additional Director General of Police (Law and Order) to visit the site and oversee the probe. Former Deputy CM of Bihar and RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav, said in a social media post: "Respected, Prime Minister, Narendra Modi Ji, houses of Dalits have been set on fire under your double

engine government in Bihar. The PM must say a few words on this 'Mangalraj' as whatever is happening is all because of the will of almighty God and the NDA leaders have no control over this."

BSP president Mayawati demanded strict action by the Bihar government. The former Uttar Pradesh chief minister also called for full financial support by the government for rehabilitation of the poor victims.

Congress too slammed the NDA government in Bihar over the incident of setting ablaze of houses in Nawada, saying it is another proof of the "jungle raj" prevailing in the state and shows the dispensation's "utter indifference" towards Dalits and the deprived.

## Plans Underway for Incredible India's Vibrant Tribal Homestays

Get ready to explore the stunning beauty and vibrant culture of India's tribal regions like never before! Exciting plans are underway to encourage tribal communities to welcome tourists to their homes, allowing them to share their unique heritage. Supporting this remarkable initiative, the Union Tourism Ministry plans to promote, to begin with, 1,000 Homestays at tourism-potential villages across the tribal belts of the States like Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu among others. The aim is to preserve rich traditions of the tribal communities as well as enhance their incomes, thus empowering them economically

and fostering sustainable development. The Union Tourism Ministry plans to provide funding to tribal households and villages for the construction of 5 to 10 homestays in each tourism-potential tribal village under its Swadesh Darshan program.

"Each household will be eligible for Rs 5 lakhs for the construction of two new rooms and upto Rs 3 lakhs for renovation of existing rooms and Rs 5 lakh for village community requirement," an official of the Ministry shared the details.

He said that the plan is the nascent phase and nitty-gritty will be worked out to ensure there is no violation of the regulations and tribals and visitors rights are

protected. The Ministry's Homestay scheme in tribal areas is part of the central flagship Pradhan Mantri Janatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan which was cleared by the Union Cabinet

Ministry, a day ago. With a total outlay of Rs.79,156 crore (Central Share: Rs.56,333 crore and State Share: Rs. 22,823 crore), the scheme aims to improve the socio-economic condition of tribal

communities, by adopting saturation coverage for tribal families in tribal-majority villages and aspirational districts. Around 5 crore tribals in the 63,000 villages are expected to benefit as 549 districts and 2,740 blocks spread across all tribal majority villages in 30 States/UTs will be covered. The Ministry comprises 25 interventions/schemes which will be implemented by 17-line ministries. Each Ministry/Department would be responsible for implementation of schemes related to it in a time bound manner through funds allocated to them under the Development Action Plan for Scheduled Tribes (DAPST) in the next 5 years, as per the official. India has a scheduled tribes

population of 10.45 crore as per 2011 census and there are more than 705 tribal communities, spread across the country, living in remote and hard-to-reach areas. As the Union Tourism Ministry advances plans for homestays in tribal regions, the Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board (MPTB) is already leading the way. Many tribal families have opened their homes as homestays as a part of the homestay project of the MPTB, and are now ready to host visitors. According to the MPTB officials, rural tribal communities have established over 64 new homestays across 28 villages. Post-COVID, homestays have become a favored option for travelers seeking unique and personal experiences. "They often

allow guests to immerse themselves in local culture, enjoy homemade meals, and access off-the-beaten-path attractions. For homeowners, turning a property into a homestay can be financially rewarding, providing a steady income stream while allowing them to share their space and hospitality with others." It's a win-win, creating memorable experiences for guests and fostering connections between visitors and local communities, said an official from the Ministry. According to Cognitive Market Research, India homestay market had a market share of USD 540.44 million in 2024 and is projected to grow at a Compounded Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 11.0% during the forecast period.

# BJP promises 2 Lakh Govt jobs in Haryana, Rs 2,100 per Month to Women

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) on Thursday released its manifesto for the assembly polls, promising two Lakh government jobs to the youth, a Rs 2,100 monthly assistance for women, scooter for college-going female students in rural areas and a guaranteed government job for 'Agniveers'.

It also promised to build 5 lakh houses in urban and rural areas if it is voted to power in the October 5 assembly elections.

Union minister and BJP president J P Nadda released the manifesto called 'sankalp patra' at Rohtak in the presence of Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, Union Ministers M L Khattar, Rao Inderjit Singh, Krishan Pal Gurjar, state BJP chief Mohan Lal Badoli and the party's poll manifesto committee head O P Dhanakar.

The party also promised to purchase 24 crops at a Minimum Support Price (MSP). The BJP government in Haryana was already buying 14 crops at MSP. And last month, the state cabinet approved a proposal to buy 10 more crops at MSP.

Nadda said there will be a



guarantee of government jobs for every Agniveer hailing from Haryana.

Among the 20 main points in the manifesto, the BJP promised Rs 2,100 per month for all women under the Lado Lakshmi Yojna and a scooter for college-going female students in rural areas under Avval Balika Yojna. The ruling party said two lakh government jobs will be given to the youth without 'kharchi-parchi', a reference to the alleged corruption prevailing earlier under the Congress regime. All those youth who pass Common Eligibility Test, but cannot get job within a year, will get Rs 9,000 per month in lieu of 100 hours of work under Saksham

Yuva Yojana for the next two years, says the manifesto.

The ruling BJP also said it will give cooking gas cylinder at Rs 500 under the Har Ghar Grihini Yojna, under which BPL and antyodaya families in the state get these in the recently started scheme. The BJP has promised, if it returns to power, its government will guarantee loans up to Rs 25 lakh for all OBC entrepreneurs, in addition to the Mudra scheme, as per manifesto.

The party promised to frame strict laws to check drug menace, make stringent laws for drug trafficking and relat-

ed offences with a minimum imprisonment of 10 years which may be extended to life term and a fine of at least Rs 5 lakh. NDPS Fast track courts will be set up in all districts, the party promised.

O P Dhanakar said there is something in the manifesto for every section. Chief Minister Saini said special attention has been given to the poor, youth,

farmers and women. District-specific announcements also find a mention in the manifesto. Full scholarships for Haryana students belonging to the OBC and SC communities in any government medical and engineering colleges in the country will be given, the BJP manifesto states.

The BJP has also promised free dialysis in government hospitals and diagnosis in all hospitals. Rapid rail transport system will be started from Delhi to Palwal, Dharuhera, Rohtak and Panipat with the centre's assistance, said Nadda. It also promised setting up 10 industrial cities on the line of Industrial Model Township Kharkhoda, and said industrialists will be given special incentive for giving 50,000 jobs to local youths in every city.

According to the manifesto, the party will set up welfare boards for backward classes (36 biradari) while sports nurseries will come up in every district for Olympic Games. Tourism was also the focus in the manifesto with the party promising an Aravalli Jungle Safari of international level in south Haryana.

The party also promised to raise the strength of women personnel in state police force from 15 percent to 25 percent. Among the promises for farmers include an incentive of Rs 10,000 per acre to farmers who sow crops other than paddy and a law to ensure punishment for those who sell fake fertilizers, seeds and pesticides will be implemented.

## BJP has not yet fulfilled the promises of 2014 and 2019, again made slogans in 2024: Bhupinder Hooda

Former Haryana Chief Minister and Leader of Opposition Bhupinder Singh Hooda on Thursday said that the manifesto released by BJP has stamped the failures of its own government. The BJP, which could not fulfill its promises made in 2014 and 2019, has made new slogans in 2024 to mislead the public, but now the truth of this government has been exposed in front of the public, he added.

Talking to reporters, Hooda said that BJP remembered Laado Laxmi Yojana after 10 years, because Congress had announced to give Rs 2000 per month to women in its 7 guarantees just a day before. "That is why BJP has announced Rs 2100 following Congress. The BJP had also announced to give Rs 9000 allowance to unemployed youth in 2014, but this promise vanished in thin air," he said.

In addition to boosting the economy, the project will generate thousands of jobs, particularly for the youth, aligning with the state's vision of fostering growth and development through large-scale industrial initiatives.

## Punjab Police launches 'Saanjh Rahat Project' to support victims of domestic violence

Punjab Police on Thursday launched a new initiative — the 'Saanjh Rahat Project' — aimed at identifying and supporting victims of domestic violence. The project focuses on empowering women affected by domestic abuse by providing them with essential psycho-social and legal support to lead violence-free lives. Launched in collaboration with the Indore-based NGO Nai Shuruwat, the project is a multi-agency initiative involving key partners like the Health Department, Department of Social Security and Women and Child Development, State Legal Services Authority, and District Legal Services Authority.

DGP Gaurav Yadav, speaking at the launch, said, "This initiative will bridge the gap in support services for victims of domestic violence, empowering them to make informed decisions about their future." The pilot phase of the project has been launched at the Civil Hospital in SAS Nagar (Mohali), where two dedicated counselors are stationed to identify and assist victims. The project will eventually expand across the state.

## Punjab Health Minister debunks Rs 600-cr arrear claim under Ayushman

A day after Punjab's private hospitals stopped cashless services under Ayushman scheme alleging that the State Government failed to clear Rs 600 crore dues, the state's Health and Family Welfare Minister Dr Balbir Singh on Thursday strongly refuted the claims made by the Private Hospitals and Nursing Home Association (PHANA) Punjab.

Dubbing PHANA's claims that the State Government owes over Rs 600 crore for various treatments availed under the Ayushman Bharat Mukh Mantri Sehat Bima Yojna as "false and misleading", Dr Balbir revealed that the total pending amount for both public and private hospitals is just Rs 364 crores.

As per the official data, the breakdown of pending payments shows that Rs 166.67 crores are owed to public hospitals, while private hospitals are due Rs 197 crores. The clarification comes a day after PHANA announced that it would stop all treatments under the

Ayushman Bharat Mukh Mantri Sehat Bima Yojna across empaneled private hospitals in the State.

Health Minister said that since April 1, 2024, the Government has disbursed Rs 101.66 crores to private hospitals and Rs 112 crores to public hospitals, totaling Rs 214.30 crores.

Dr Balbir explained that technical glitches arose from February 2024 after switching to new software for claim processing launched by National Health Agency (NHA), which resulted in slowing down the claim processing. However, the State Health Agency (SHA) took prompt measures including deputing more staff and working on weekends and holidays, to address the issue.

To resolve the matter, the Health Minister has called a meeting with PHANA representatives on Friday. Additionally, a meeting with the Indian Medical Association (IMA) has also been fixed on September 25, 2024, at 3:30 pm to address any concerns regarding payments and SHA functioning.

## Punjab sees 26% spike in stamp and registration revenue for Aug '24

Punjab Government recorded a 26 percent increase in revenue from stamp and registration fees in August 2024, reflecting its commitment to transparency and efficiency. Revenue Minister Bram Shanker Jimpa on Thursday credited this surge to Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann's leadership and efforts to provide hassle-free, corruption-free services.

The state's income under this head reached Rs 440.92 crore in August 2024, up from Rs 349.26 crore in August 2023. Jimpa highlighted that the revenue growth has been consistent, with a 71 percent increase in July 2024, 42 percent in June, and 22 percent in May. From April to July 2024, the total revenue stood at Rs 1854.12 crore — a significant rise from Rs 1461.87 crore during the same period in 2023.

Jimpa emphasized that the government's anti-corruption measures, including a helpline for complaints, have played a key role in boosting public confidence. He urged the citizens to report any instances of bribery, reiterating that the state remains dedicated to providing clean governance.

## Punjab Transport Minister cracks down on illegal permit clubbing

To ensure compliance with transport regulations and foster fair competition, Punjab Transport Minister Lajit Singh Bhullar on Thursday ordered a comprehensive review of all composite permits issued under Rule 80-A of the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. The crackdown is aimed at curbing the illegal clubbing of stage carriage permits and operational irregularities in the state's transport sector. Bhullar emphasized that the rule mandates a single composite permit with an equal number of return trips, not a cluster of permits. He directed the officials to de-club any permits found violating Rule 80-A, and restore them to their original status through proper legal channels. This action responds to a surge in legal challenges in the Punjab and Haryana High Court, where operators have questioned the legality of composite permits. The Minister stressed that this initiative targeted monopolistic practices in the sector, particularly those of large bus operators. "Our goal is to dismantle the unfair advantages some big players have gained through illegal permit clubbing," Bhullar said, adding that this move would create a level playing field for small and medium-sized operators, ultimately benefiting the public through better services.

## Punjab DSP booked for bribery in drug case, absconding

In a crackdown against corruption within its own ranks, Punjab Police's Anti-Narcotic Task Force (ANTF) has booked Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Vavinder Kumar Mahajan for allegedly accepting Rs 45 lakh bribe to protect a pharmaceutical company involved in violations of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

Despite a raid at his Amritsar residence on Wednesday, Mahajan managed to flee moments before the police arrived. His name surfaced after the recent arrest of drug inspector Shishan Mittal, linking Mahajan to a larger

conspiracy. Mahajan is presently posted as DSP in Punjab Armed Police (PAP) 9th Battalion, Amritsar.

Mahajan's involvement in corrupt practices came to light during the investigation of a major drug bust earlier this year. In February 2024, the ANTF seized 1.98 crore Alprazolam tablets and 40 kilograms of raw Alprazolam, setting off a chain of inquiries that eventually led to Mahajan.

Director General of Police (DGP) Gaurav Yadav confirmed that Mahajan, while serving in the ANTF, accepted a bribe from Aster Pharma to shield them from legal action in a drug-related case. "The ANTF uncovered serious NDPS violations during a joint inspection at M/s Smilax

Pharmachem Drug Industries in May 2024. Preliminary investigations revealed that DSP Mahajan accepted Rs 45 lakhs from Aster Pharma to safeguard their interests," said Yadav.

The case intensified after the ANTF arrested drug inspector Shishan Mittal a few weeks ago. Mittal, accused of facilitating drug smuggling and laundering money, provided crucial information about Mahajan's role during interrogation. Authorities recovered Rs 1.49 crore in cash, 260 grams of gold, and 515 Dirhams from Mittal, and his illegally acquired assets, including flats worth Rs two crore and multiple bank accounts totaling Rs 7.09 crore, were frozen.





## Sri Lanka's pivotal presidential election

With traditional parties in decline and new alliances emerging, this election may spring surprises. The outcome will determine Sri Lanka's capacity to address its urgent challenges

Sri Lanka faces a pivotal moment in its political history as it prepares for the presidential election this Saturday, 21 September. This election, the ninth for the executive presidency, unfolds amid severe political polarisation, sharply contrasting with the last election in November 2019. The decline of traditional political parties and the rise of various political alliances are prominent features of this election, with three main candidates competing in a manner distinct from the two-horse races of previous presidential contests. The fragmentation of political parties, the absence of anti-defection laws, and the formation of new alliances driven more by personal interests than by cohesive agendas pose significant risks to democratic stability and governance. The 2019 presidential race featured two main candidates and a notable but relatively minor third-party candidate. It saw a record voter registration of 15,992,096 and a turnout of 83.72% (13,387,951), surpassing previous highs of 81.52% in 2015 and 81.06% in 1982. Despite this high turnout, 135,452 votes were invalid, leaving 13,252,499 votes as valid. Gotabaya Rajapaksa of the Sri Lanka Podujana Peramuna won with 52.25% of the valid votes (6,924,255), while his main opponent, Sajith Premadasa of the National Democratic Front, received 41.99% (5,564,239). Anura Kumara Disnayake of the National People's Power secured a mere 3.16% (418,553 votes). In the subsequent general election on 5 August 2020, Premadasa and Disnayake faced off again for parliamentary seats. Premadasa won 305,744 votes, while Disnayake received 49,814 votes.

In the 2015 parliamentary elections, Premadasa garnered 112,645 votes from Hambantota, whereas Disnayake, contesting from Colombo, secured 65,966 votes. Ranil Wickremesinghe, one of main three main contenders, in this year's race but absent from the 2019 presidential election, leads the United National Party. His party received 249,435 votes (2.25%) in the general elections, including 30,875 from Colombo and 28,282 from Gampaha. Although his party did not win a parliamentary seat, Wickremesinghe was appointed to a national list position. Amid severe social upheaval caused by economic mismanagement, which resulted in the resignation of both the President and Prime Minister, Wickremesinghe, a seasoned politician and six-time Prime Minister, capitalised on the moment to make his comeback. After Prime Minister Mahinda Rajapaksa was forced to resign, Wickremesinghe was appointed as Prime Minister.

However, protests demanding the resignation of President Gotabaya Rajapaksa led to his dramatic escape, first to Trincomalee by navy ship, then back to Colombo by air force chopper, and finally to the Maldives by air force cargo flight. Rajapaksa officially resigned on 14 July 2022. Subsequently, Prime Minister Wickremesinghe was appointed as President by the constitutional process. Wickremesinghe's appointment highlights the complexities of Sri Lanka's political system.

According to the constitution, the President must appoint a Prime Minister who commands the majority's confidence in Parliament, illustrating the considerable unchecked powers inherent in the executive role. Rajapaksa's assumption that Wickremesinghe, who came to Parliament through the national list, was the candidate who earned the majority's confidence reflects the intricate dynamics of Sri Lanka's

politics. However, Wickremesinghe has effectively stabilised the situation after the social upheaval. In this context, Wickremesinghe has emerged as a major candidate, yet the Sri Lanka Podujana Peramuna has nominated its candidate, Namal Rajapaksa.

Reports suggest that Rajapaksa's ambitions to secure the prime ministership were opposed, leading a faction of his party to break away from Wickremesinghe. Rajapaksa's candidacy appears more focused on maintaining his family's political lineage rather than presenting a genuine bid for leadership. Nonetheless, his endorsement of supporting Sajith Premadasa, where he appeals to supporters to cast their second vote for Premadasa, could be a decisive factor in the election outcome. Meanwhile, the NPP, initially opposed to the public uprising that led to Rajapaksa's removal, has become a significant political entity.

Anura Kumara Disnayake, who ironically led his political party into alliances with traditional parties to secure ministerial positions over the past few decades, has skilfully capitalised on widespread dissatisfaction with corruption and the growing anger towards conventional politicians to bolster his standing. His alliance's emotionally charged propaganda has infiltrated every corner of society, despite its lack of deep ideological substance. The Janatha Vimukthi Peramuna (JVP), his original party, has skilfully harnessed this discontent to challenge the status quo.

However, Disnayake's path to victory remains uncertain, especially with three major candidates in the race. Voter statistics reveal additional obstacles: with 17.1 million registered voters and an anticipated 80% turnout (13.7 million), a candidate would need approxi-

mately 7 million votes to secure the presidency in the first count.

The NPP's past performance shows limited success, receiving 418,553 votes (3.16%) in 2019 and 445,950 votes (3.84%) in parliamentary elections in 2020. The party faces challenges in Tamil-majority districts like Nuwara-Eliya, Jaffna, Wannai, Batticaloa, and Trincomalee, and in areas with lower voter counts, such as Polonnaruwa and Matale. To succeed, the NPP must secure substantial votes from Colombo, Gampaha, Kalutara, Kandy, and Kurunegala, requiring an estimated 700,000 to 800,000 additional votes.

Given these dynamics and the competition among three candidates, the NPP or JVP may struggle to achieve significant success in this election. However, the election remains crucial in determining the country's social and governance structure. Conversely, Sajith Premadasa appears to have significant potential to garner a majority of the votes, while Wickremesinghe has also gained substantial ground. Therefore, it is unlikely that any candidate will secure over 50% of the vote in the first round of counting, which may necessitate counting the second votes.

This uncertainty could trigger a new wave of political instability if major alliances and key candidates fail to manage the results effectively and refuse to accept the people's verdict. Despite flashy manifestos and hefty campaign budgets, none of the candidates have provided a clear plan to tackle the staggering \$100 billion national debt. They all parrot the same old IMF rhetoric, yet almost none offer a concrete strategy beyond this worn-

The situation in the island nation is dire, and there's no straightfor-

ward path for the incoming leader to steer the country out of its deepening crisis. As of 1 July 2024, about 24.8% of Sri Lanka's population lives in poverty, with rates varying dramatically between districts—3.5% in Colombo versus 44.2% in Nuwara-Eliya.

Poverty in rural areas has surged from 15% to 32%, while urban poverty has tripled from 6% to 18%. A recent survey revealed that 31% of the population is impoverished, with 33% skipping meals and 47% cutting back on meal sizes. Malnutrition affects nearly one-third of children under five, and over 40% of women aged 18-60 are overweight or obese, reflecting severe economic and health issues. Regardless of the election's outcome, Sri Lanka's entrenched political divisions threaten to entrench a fragmented legislative body, where effective governance and decisive action may become increasingly elusive.

Such divisions risk entrenching a cycle of delays and inefficiencies, potentially leading to a state of perpetual gridlock that hampers national progress. Antonio Gramsci's notion of passive revolution becomes pertinent here, warning of significant changes that merely preserve existing power structures. Hannah Arendt's insight that "The most radical revolution will become a conservative the day after the revolution" cautions against decisions driven by emotion over reason.

Thus, the question looms: can this election transcend emotional politics to instigate genuine reform, or will it simply entrench the status quo? Regrettably, the candidates' manifestos seem to hint at the lat-

## Chronicles of compliance: The missing case diaries in money laundering probes

Money laundering poses a significant threat to society, undermines democratic institutions, and fosters criminal activities and corruption

The international community established the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) to combat money laundering and terrorist financing through international standards. The FATF's 40 Recommendations provide a comprehensive framework for countries to prevent and address these financial crimes. India enacted the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) in 2002, effective from July 1, 2005, in alignment with its international obligations. The PMLA aims to combat the laundering of illicit funds, including those from activities such as drug trafficking, thereby safeguarding the country's financial integrity.

Section 172 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC), maintains a chronological record of the investigation process conducted by the police officer. This detailed documentation includes every step taken during the investigation, such as the date and time of receiving information about the crime, the start and finish times of the investigation, locations visited, witness statements recorded, and evi-

dence collected. This comprehensive record ensures continuity and transparency in the investigation, serving as a crucial handover document when different officers handle the case at various stages. The case diary is essential for maintaining continuity and transparency in the investigation process, offering a comprehensive overview of progress to courts and defence lawyers. This transparency is indispensable for maintaining procedural integrity and accountability in the investigative process.

**Concerns Regarding the Absence of a Case Diary under PMLA:** In contrast, the PMLA mandates thorough investigations into money laundering but does not specify the need for a

detailed case diary as in the CrPC. This absence raises concerns about potential misuse by the Enforcement Directorate. Without a mandated case diary, there is no obligation for investigators to maintain a comprehensive, chronological record of their actions. This lack of documentation could reduce accountability and allow for the manipulation or selective presentation of evidence without a transparent trail of how and when it was obtained, compromising the investigation's integrity.

This can lead to biased or unjust conclusions, undermining the integrity of the investigation and in cases where multiple officers are involved in different stages of the investigation, the absence



of a detailed case diary can result in inconsistent handovers. Critical information might be lost or altered, impacting the continuity and coherence of the investigation. This ultimately leads to violations of individual rights and compromise on due process of law.

**Case Diary Maintenance:** It is important to understand that the accused under CrPC does not have an automatic right to

view the case diary. Access to the case diary is at the discretion of the Court or the police officer. However, the significance of maintaining a case diary as noted above lies in its ability to keep investigating agencies diligent and accountable throughout the investigation process.

Furthermore, under the criminal law procedure, it is considered a dereliction of duty if the Magistrate does not request and review the case diary before authorizing any form of custody to the accused which means the perusal of the case diary by the magistrate is essential before any remand, whether judicial or police custody and haphazard maintenance of a case diary discredits those responsible and defeats the very purpose for

which it is required. Therefore, it is suggested that similar practice needs to be followed under the PMLA cases as well. Mandating ED to maintain a case diary ensures that it adheres to the due process of law during investigations and thereafter, the court will become entitled to use the case diary during trials or inquiries as an aid in the inquiry or trial, thereby holding the ED accountable for its investigative procedures, doing this the magistrate will be getting aid and true picture of the detailed record of the investigation proceedings conducted by ED till date in a narrative form, recorded promptly, with sufficient detail, and in chronological order and thus, will be able to objectively decide whether to remand the

accused or not. The Supreme Court is set to review 2 aspects of PMLA in July 2024, firstly, the FIR which is akin to ECIR under PMLA should be supplied to the accused or not. Secondly, the reversal of the presumption of innocence. It is to be noted that giving a case diary a statutory requirement under PMLA and thereby, mandating the ED to maintain one will be crucial in shaping the final judgement, which could fundamentally impact the legal framework for money laundering investigations in India. A ruling in favour of maintaining a case diary would enhance the fairness and transparency of PMLA proceedings, ensuring the accused's right to a fair trial.

# ASHWIN, JADEJA TANGO SAVES INDIA AFTER HASAN MAHMUD'S EARLY STRIKES

Seasoned off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin sparked on home turf with his sixth Test hundred as he combined with Ravindra Jadeja to steer India out of trouble and post a formidable 339 for six on day one of the first Test against Bangladesh here on Thursday. Ashwin (102 batting) and Jadeja (86 batting) added 195 runs (174 minutes, 225 balls) for a riveting unbroken seventh wicket stand after young pacer Hasan Mahmud (4/58) reduced India to 144 for six, despite Yashasvi Jaiswal making a solid 56. The ebb and flow of the day's proceedings was quite remarkable and mostly revolved around Ashwin, Jadeja and Mahmud, who made his Test debut in March this year and was just three games old in the format before this match. In a stunning first spell of 5-2-6-3, the 24-year-old Mahmud accounted for the cream of Indian top-order -- Rohit Sharma (6), Shubman Gill (0) and Virat Kohli (6) -- before snapping Rishabh Pant's return to Test cricket (39 off 52 balls) in the initial moments of the second session. KL Rahul, another Indian batter who is re-entering the Indian Test establishment, fell for 16 to off-spinner Mehidy

Hasan Miraz as fortune's pendulum stayed firmly in Bangladesh's quarter. But then came the two gladiators who know Chepauk like the back of their hand -- Ashwin by birth and Jadeja through his long association with the Chennai Super Kings. One more wicket at that stage would have extended the dominance of Bangladesh, but such thoughts hardly disturbed Ashwin and Jadeja. Ashwin went off the blocks with a flurry of boundaries, a firm validation of his oh-so-smooth timing born out of fluent hand movement through shots and precise footwork. There was this ramp shot off Mahmud, who tried to rattle Ashwin with a short-pitched delivery that climbed onto his body. But the veteran player arched himself back ever so slightly to gain space to execute the ramp over the slip -- fabulous in conceptualisation and execution. At times, he scored at a strike rate in excess of 100 and was not hesitant to travel the more uncultured way. A slog sweep that went for six over mid-wicket off left-arm spinner Shakib Al-Hasan testified that. Jadeja was a tad different in his approach. Sensing that Ashwin was in good touch, the left-hander had the simple job of keeping his end going and he



did that with minimum fuss. A past master in operating from behind the giant shadows of superstars, Jadeja looked extremely comfortable doing that once more, providing the assurance Ashwin needed. But there were moments, the showman in Jadeja came forth and Shakib was the aggrieved party, getting hammered for three fours. Bangladesh's star of the day Mahmud, too was not spared as Jadeja, who raised his fifty off 73 balls, played a drag-pull off the pacer to send him for a six. Other times, he wing-heeled across the pitch for those ones and twos to keep the Bangladesh bowlers frustrated. The spectators eventually witnessed the moment that they had been waiting for when Ashwin reached the hundred with a single off Shakib, and they welcomed it with applause, cheers and loud bugling. It was his second consecutive hundred at his home ground after going past the three-figure mark here against England in 2021. And it could not have come at a better time as well. But before the epic fightback, the Indian innings resembled a crumbling rampart. It's not often that a team winning the toss would elect to bowl first here as that translates into a fourth-innings chase. But Bangladesh skipper Najmul Hossain Shanto bit the bullet while going against the trend, and was rewarded for it too. Rohit, who was saved by DRS when he was on 1, was the first to depart. The Indian skipper had little choice other than playing a wobble seam delivery that came at him on a tight angle as he edged to Shanto at second slip. Gill lasted just eight balls but he would count himself unlucky, feathering Mahmud's down the leg side delivery to stumper Litton Das. Kohli walked into the Chepauk amid loud cheers and looked confident. But an old failing resurfaced to haunt him. Mahmud pitched one just short of the length outside the off-stump, and the length was not suitable for a drive. But the star batter chose to play an expansive one with the ball nestling in Litton's gloves after taking a healthy edge off his bat. Jaiswal and Pant added 62 runs for the fourth wicket to temporarily check the free fall before both perished in close succession in the middle session. Bangladesh might have thought the effort was good enough to keep the home side flat on the ropes, but Ashwin and Jadeja made them wiser as to why it is so tough to keep India on the back-foot at home for long.



## Indian women crush Georgia; Gukesh leads men to victory over China

Grandmaster R Vaishali and Vantika Agrawal put up impressive performances as Indian women defeated Georgia while World Championship challenger D Gukesh led the men to victory over China in the seventh round as both teams continued their unbeaten streak in 45th Chess Olympiad here. Vaishali and Vantika notched wins against Lela Javakhishvili and Bella Khotenashvili as Indian women thumped second seeds Georgia 3-1, while the men eked out a 2.5-1.5 over China. On a day that saw D Harika settling for a draw with Nana Dzagnidze and Divya Deshmukh being held by Nino Batsiashvili from a better position, it was Vantika who handled her time pressure extremely well to play almost 20 moves with just about a minute on her clock to win her game and seal India's seventh straight victory. The Indian women took their tally to an impressive 14 points out of a possible 14 and stretched their lead to two points over nearest rivals Poland, Kazakhstan and France who all have 12 points apiece. In a surprising turn of events a blunder by Olivia Kiobasa of Poland against Nataliya Buksa of Ukraine cost the Polish team dearly in the sixth hour of play as what looked like a certain victory became a 2-2 draw. In the open section, Indian Grandmaster Gukesh showed the way. Playing the white side of a Closed Sicilian Gukesh reached a drawn endgame after nearly five hours of play but he remained focus to find one mistake that was made by Chinese top board Wei Yi. Speculation were rife about a possible clash between D Gukesh and Ding Liren - the two contestants in the next World Championship for a final showdown ahead of their match in Singapore in November. However, the Chinese think

tank decided to rest the reigning world champion. That was already a shock for the pundits of the game. R Praggnanandhaa played out a quick draw as black against Yangyi Yu of China while P Harikrishna pressed for some time before the position petered out to be equal in the ensuing rook and pawns endgame against Wang Yue of China on the fourth board. Earlier Arjun Erigaise went for the kill against an alert Bu Xiangzhi and the latter found a nice piece sacrifice to force a draw through repetition. With just four rounds to come, the Indian men have done everything correct thus far and are sitting pretty with a 100 percent score like their female counterparts. Iran is the only team in close pursuit of the leaders on 13 points while a pack of four teams - Serbia, Hungary, Armenia and defending champions Uzbekistan share the third spot on 12 points each. ## Kevin de Bruyne injury scare as Man City is held 0-0 by Inter Milan in the Champions League

Manchester City faces a new injury concern for Kevin de Bruyne ahead of a showdown with Premier League title rival Arsenal at halftime of Champions League match against Inter Milan. The Belgium international looked in discomfort after making a run late in the first half. After receiving treatment, De Bruyne didn't return for the second half and was replaced by Ilkay Gundogan. The game ended 0-0. City hosts title rival Arsenal at Etihad Stadium on Sunday. City manager Pep Guardiola said he didn't know the extent of De Bruyne's injury, but was informed by the club doctor the playmaker could not carry on in the second half. "I didn't speak with the doctors yet," Guardiola said about De Bruyne's availability for the weekend. "He will be assessed tonight, maybe tomorrow. We will have more info tomorrow." De Bruyne endured an injury-disrupted campaign last season when he was sidelined from August to January with a hamstring problem. He returned to help the club secure a record fourth straight English title. He has started every game this season and scored in City's 4-1 win against Ipswich last month. City held off challenges from Arsenal in each of the last two seasons to lift the title. The north London club is expected to be City's main rival again this term. Arsenal has its own injury



problems ahead of the game after captain Martin Odegaard was ruled out with ankle ligament damage. Without De Bruyne, City failed to find a breakthrough against Inter and was shut out at home in the Champions League for the first time since a 0-0 draw with Sporting Lisbon in March 2022. It was only the second time in all competitions since then that Guardiola's team failed to score at home - the other coming in a 0-0 with Arsenal in the league in March. City extended its unbeaten home run in European games to 32, dating back to a 2-1 loss to Lyon in 2018. Haaland locked on 99 Erling Haaland has looked unstoppable this season with nine goals in his first four games of the campaign before Wednesday match. But that run was snapped by Inter with the Norway striker stuck on 99 goals for City. Haaland also failed to score against the Italians when the teams met in the Champions League final in 2023, which City won 1-0 to lift the trophy for the first time in its history. "They are masters of defending," Guardiola said. With his contract expiring at the end of the season, Guardiola sounds like he's still loving life at City. Asked by an Italian journalist if he could see himself working in Italy in the future, Guardiola said: "I really enjoy being here. I love English football, it is fantastic, really enjoyable. They leave you alone to get on with the job. That doesn't happen anywhere else."

## PSG's post-galactico era begins with a last-gasp win

### THANKS TO GIRONA GOALKEEPER'S BLUNDER

It took a huge blunder to gift Paris Saint-Germain victory in the first Champions League match of its post-galactico era. PSG scraped a 1-0 home win over tournament newcomer Girona on Wednesday with a stoppage-time goal, which came when goalkeeper Paulo Gazzaniga let a left-wing cross from Nuno Mendes trickle under his hands and through his legs. For the first time in more than a decade, PSG began its Champions League campaign without at least one star player, known in soccer as a "galactico." It was the likes of Zlatan Ibrahimovic, Edinson Cavani, Neymar, Kylian Mbappé and Lionel Messi came and went without winning Europe's elite club competition. PSG started this campaign with a new identity based on more French players and greater teamwork.

It was also PSG's first Champions League game without Mbappé for seven years after France's star joined Real Madrid, scoring for his new club on Tuesday. Mbappé was reproached by his critics for not tracking back or closing down enough when he played up front for PSG. Yet PSG coach Luis Enrique could be heard shouting when his players failed to close down properly and, at one point, Girona kept the ball for 2 1/2 minutes with PSG's ball-watching players chasing aimlessly. "They defended well and we struggled to create clear-cut chances," Enrique said. After 34 minutes, whistles could be heard from the crowd at a subdued Parc des Princes. Aside from half-chances from midfielder Warren Zaire-Emery and Marco Asensio, who went off injured late in the first half with an apparent hamstring injury, there was scant attacking play. "All the teams have things to improve," Zaire-Emery said. "We have new players coming into the team who need to settle in." Yet this was even more the case for a Girona team that lost several key players from last season, including striker Artem Dovbyk, winger Savinho and right back Yan Couto. Girona defender Ladislav Krejci made a brilliant tackle on Ousmane Dembélé after the PSG attacker went clean through on goal in the first half. But with moments left, Gazzaniga's howler spared PSG. "We didn't play very well, and we have to say it," PSG midfielder Vinha said. "We had trouble keeping the ball. You have to give Girona credit, but we need to look at what we didn't do well."

## Malvika beats Kristy Gilmour to enter China Open quarterfinals

Young Indian shuttler Malvika Bansod continued her fine form as she cruised to her maiden Super 1000 quarterfinal after eking out a hard-fought victory against higher-ranked Kristy Gilmour in the China Open here on Thursday. Malvika, ranked 43rd, toiled hard for one hour and five minutes before pulling off a 21-17 19-21 21-16 win over the two-time Commonwealth Games medallist and world number 25 from Scotland in a women's singles round-of-16 contest. "This is the first time I will play a quarterfinal of a Super 1000 tournament so it is a dream come true and the biggest achievement of my life so far," Malvika said after the match. "I dreamt about this before the tournament that how would it be if I reached the quarters and now I'm top 8, so it's a great feeling," she added.



Talking about the match, the Indian, who now leads head-to-head against Gilmour 3-2, said "There is a lot of drift from this part so I found it difficult to control in the last parts of the last game and second game as well. But I'm glad god helped me." The win comes a day after the 22-year-old defeated Paris Olympics bronze medallist Gregoria Mariska Tunjung of Indonesia. The Nagpur shuttler feels she has been able to control the shuttle in the tricky conditions here. "My retrieving is working well, I am able to control the shuttle better than the others. The conditions are a bit tricky for both players but I'm able to

handle it better," she said. She added that she has focused on enhancing her strength, and it is yielding positive results. "This circuit is very tough because if you are entering a Super 500 or 1000 you end up playing a top 10 in the first round as I'm not seeded yet. So, I need to be physically strong from the beginning itself. I have been working on that." However Malvika, who is the lone Indian shuttler remaining in the competition, has a tough challenge ahead of her as she will be up against fourth seed and two-time world champion Akane Yamaguchi of Japan in the last eight stage. Although the Japanese shuttler has won both the outings against Malvika, the Indian had come close to defeating Yamaguchi and hopes she can cross the line this time round. "Hope for the best. I am in good form let's see how it goes tomorrow. I will give my best," she said.
