# TRUMP AND HIS TRUMPET

President Donald Trump has once again raised USAID's purported \$21-million grant for 'voter turnout' in India, which his administration has purportedly cancelled, and linked it to Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Trump, as usual, also questioned why such a significant amount was spent abroad when a similar sum could have been used to boost voter turnout in the US.

"And \$21 million going to my friend, Prime Minister Modi in India, for voter turnout. We are giving 21 million for voter turnout in India. What about us? I want voter turnout too,"

Trump said at the Governors

Working Session.

\$29 million to strengthen the landscape Bangladesh went to a firm that nobody ever heard of. Got 29 million. They got a check. Can you imagine? You have a little firm, you get 10,000 here, 10,000 there, and then you get 29 million from the United States government. There are two people working in that firm. Two people. I think they're very happy, they're very rich. They'll be on the cover of a very good business magazine pretty soon for being great," he added.

Meanwhile, a federal judge has cleared the way for the Trump administration to pull thousands of US Agency International

Development staffers off the

US District Judge Carl Nichols on Friday removed his temporary block on the effort to remove all but a small fraction of USAID staffers from their posts and give those abroad a 30-day

deadline to move back to the US at government expense. His ruling comes in a lawsuit filed by unions on behalf of workers. They say the rush to dismantle the agency had cut off some staffers overseas from emergency

communications systems, including some in danger of political violence in Congo. Nichols found that the unions' challenge must be dealt with under federal employment laws rather than in district court.

# **BJP, Congress slugfest over USAID**

Trump Administration raising the issue of USAID funding has created massive political ramifications, allegations and counter allegations amongst the Centre, ruling party BJP and Opposition Congress.

Trump's remark has evoked a sharp response from the Congress which urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to "talk to his friend" and strongly refute the allegation. The Opposition party has demanded a white paper on the funds received in India from developmental agencies, aid mechanisms and multilateral forums.

Minister of External Affairs S Jaishankar called the accusations "worrisome" and said that "if there's something to it, then the country should know who the people are involved in it."

BJP IT Cell Chief Amit Malviya shared Trump's remarks in a social media post on X and took a swipe at the Opposition which later posted the complete posted complete statement of Trump where he called Modi his friend.

"For the third day in a row, US President Donald Trump reiterates his claim about USAID funding efforts to promote voter turnout in Îndia. He says, We're giving \$21 million for voter turnout in India. What about us? I want voter turnout too. But what does he know about his own country's spending," Malviva said.

Malviya faced wrath of Congress Media and Publicity Head Pawan Khera who said perhaps Malviya erred in sharing the video of Trump



who has clearly named PM Modi yet he tries to defend implicate Congress aimlessly.

Congress also sought legal action against the RSS-BJP "their ecosystem" for making wild allegations against credible civil society members, NGOs and political parties. Jaishankar Saturday for the first time spoke about the allegations levied by former US President Donald Trump against USAID's \$21 million funding for 'voter turnout in India'. While speaking at the Delhi

University Literature Festival, EAM Jaishankar said, "Some information has been put out there by the Trump administration people, and obviously, that concerning... I think, as a government, we're looking into it. My sense is that the facts will come out...USAID was allowed here in good faith, to do good faith activities; now, suggestions are being laid out from America that there are activities which are in bad faith. It's worrisome, and if

there's something to it, then the country should know who the people are involved in it." Khera said the Modi government, its ministers, its economic advisor, BJP's IT department head. ecosystem and "one-fourth media," which acts as cheerleaders for the BJP are desperately tying themselves in knots to somehow prove their allegation of 'deep state' and 'foreign intervention' with regards to 'USD 21 USAID funds million narrative?

The white paper should not only focus on USAID funding, but all such agencies which fund governments, individuals and all other entities under Indian law," Congress' media and publicity department head Pawan Khera told a press conference. Khera pointed at "three

significant developments," including Trump's remark "my friend Prime about Minister Modi."

'More Indian news media outlets have fact-checked the claim by BJP and Modi

government's minister as untrue. Funds went to Bangladesh, not India; although India received USAID funds, but not for increasing voter turnout," he

Now, American newspaper, Washington Post, has come up with a fact check and "found no evidence that USD 21 million was due to be spent for voter turnout in India or for any other purpose", even as the MEA spokesperson called this "very deeply troubling" and announced that "relevant departments and agencies are looking into this matter," he said.

Khera alleged that the RSS-BJP and its ilk are "habitual offenders" in two aspects crafting fake narratives and propagating lies and seeking external assistance destabilise the Indian state, democracy and Constitution.

Khera alleged that there is no record of a Consortium for Elections and Political Process Strengthening (CEPPS) programme matching US government's description in India.

CEPPS did have a USD 21 million USAID contract not for India, but for neighboring Bangladesh, he said. During 2012, the Anna

Hazare movement was at its peak, Arvind Kejriwal was forming his own party, Chief Minister Narendra Modi was gearing to be BJP's PM candidate. So, who benefitted from these funds? Who got 282 seats in Lok Sabha? The remaining amount started pouring in between US FY2020 and US FY2024," Khera said.

## **Need new legal** framework on OTT platforms: I&B



Therefore, on the advice of the Chief Minister, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the amendment wef 07-02-2025," the notification read.

With this amendment, Dhaliwal is now left with only the NRI Affairs department. The amendment was done on February 7 on the order of Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwat Mann. Dhaliwal had earlier been stripped of the Agriculture and Rural Development departments in May 2023 and was instead Administrative Reforms Department.

# First session of new Delhi Assembly to begin Monday

The Delhi BJP on Sunday convened a ▲ meeting of newly elected MLAs on Sunday, ahead of the first session of the eighth Legislative Assembly of Delhi, beginning from Monday with newly elected members taking oath at 11 am. Delhi Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena has appointed senior BJP leader and MLA from Gandhi Nagar Arvinder Singh Lovely as the pro-tem Speaker of the Delhi Assembly to chair the proceedings during the first sitting of the legislature on Monday. The appointment came ahead of the first sitting of the new 70-member Assembly that will take place on February 24.

According to a list by the Delhi Assembly, the three-day session will see the election of the House, Speaker and Deputy Speaker as well as the tabling of the 14 pending CAG reports on the performance of the previous AAP government.

The oath/affirmation of the newly elected members will take place at 11 am on February 24. The election of the Speaker will be held at 2 pm. Four-time MLA Arvinder Singh will perform the duties of the Office of the Speaker till the new Speaker is elected. The new members of the House will take oath before the pro-tem speaker," according to

Senior BJP MLA and former Delhi BIP president Vijender Gupta will be the



Delhi Assembly Speaker and Mohan Singh Bisht will be his deputy. According to the business list, LG Saxena will address the assembly on February 25, after which the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) reports will be tabled. Later in the day, the assembly will be open for motion of thanks on LG's

address. On February 26, the discussion on the motion of thanks on LG's address will commence at 11:00 am, after which the Deputy Speaker of the Delhi assembly will be elected.

"Being the first sitting of the Eighth

Legislative Assembly of NCT of Delhi constituted after the General Election held in February in 2025, the Members shall observe two minutes silence to mark the solemnity of the occasion. First, Chief Minister & other Ministers shall make or subscribe to oath or affirmation and thereafter other Hon'ble Members, constituency wise, shall make or subscribe to oath or affirmation. "Notice of motion for the election of the speaker can be given up to Saturday, February 22, before noon to the secretary, legislative assembly," the bulletin read.

## **'Probing all** angles in IRS officer death'



# **Protesting Farmers Meet Central Team On Their Demands**

nother round of talk Abetween the protesting farmers and a central team to discuss various demands of the farmers, including a legal guarantee for MSP on crops, began in Chandigarh on Saturday.

Agriculture Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan along with Union Minister Pralhad Joshi reached the Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Public Administration -the meeting venue in the evening to meet a 28-member farmers' delegation. Punjab Cabinet ministers Harpal Singh Cheema, Gurmeet Singh Khuddian and Lal Chand Kataruchak were also present at the meeting.

The farmers' delegation comprising Jagjit Singh

Dallewal and Sarwan Singh Pandher reached the meeting venue earlier. Dallewal (70) has been on a fast-unto-death at the Khanauri border point between Punjab and Haryana since November 26, 2024, to press the Centre to accept the agitating farmers' demands.

Farmer leader Kaka Singh Kotra said they expect their issues will be resolved in the meeting. Another farmer leader Sarwan Singh Pandher said the delegation of the Samyukta Kisan Morcha (Non-Political) and Kisan Mazdoor Morcha will take part in the meeting with a positive mind.

The farmers had earlier asked for the next meeting to be held in Delhi but the government scheduled it in Chandigarh. They have been protesting to press for their various demands for the past year.

In a letter to Dallewal and Pandher dated February 19, joint secretary in the agriculture ministry, Purna Chandra Kishan, said, "This is in continuation of the previous meeting with the leaders of SKM (Non-Political) and KMM, which was held in Chandigarh on February 14.' In this sequence, a meeting

with the ministers of the government of India and the government of Punjab on the demands of the farmers' unions has been scheduled on February 22 at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Public Administration in Chandigarh. You are cordially invited to the meeting. The discussions on February 14 came after a yearlong protest by farmers, centred mainly around the demand for a legal guarantee for MSP on farm produce.

After the meeting, Pralhad Joshi had said that Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan will lead the central team at the next meeting of which he would also be a part.

Prior to the February 14 meeting, four rounds of talks took place between central ministers and the protesting farmers in February 2024, but they remained inconclusive.

Farmers under the banner of SKM (Non-Political) and KMM have been camping at the Shambhu and Khanauri border points between Punjab and Haryana since February 13 last year after security forces did not allow them to march to Delhi to press for their various demands Besides a legal guarantee for MSP, the farmers are

demanding debt waiver, pen-

sion for farmers and farm

labourers, no hike in electric-

ity tariffs, withdrawal of police cases against farmers, and justice for the victims of the 2021 Lakhimpur Kheri violence in Uttar Pradesh. Reinstatement of the Land Acquisition Act, 2013, and compensation to the families of farmers who died during a previous agitation in 2020-21 are also part of their

## SYL Will Never Become A Reality, Asserts CM Mann

Reiterating that the state has share with any other state, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on Saturday said that Satluj Yamuna Link (SYL) canal will never become à reality and the state government is duty bound to safeguard interests of Punjab.

Talking to Reporters s on the sidelines of dedicating newly constructed SDM complex, the Chief Minister reiterated that the state has no spare water to share with any other state and there is no question of sharing even a single drop of water with anyone. He said that Punjab has no surplus water to share with any other state and reassessment of availability of water in the state is required as per international norms. Mann said that he has even recently urged the Ravi Beas Tribunal, which is on a visit to the state for site visit of the Ravi water system, to deliver justice to the people of the state by fresh reassessment.

He said that most of the blocks of the state are over exploited and the groundwater situation in the state is very grim. Likewise, he said that as most of the river resources of

the state have dried up, so it needs more water to cater to its irrigation needs. However, Mann said that the situation is so grim that Punjab only has scant water, which it is providing to the food growers adding that in such a scenario there is no question of sharing even a drop of water with any other

Replying to another query, the Chief Minister while quip-ping on theatricals by Union Minister of state Ravneet Singh Bittu, said that these rejected leaders will never be accepted by people. He said that Bittu dreams to occupy the official residence of the Chief Minister with all these tantrums but they are of no use as this is the house of the masses, who elect and send the leaders here, but people will never elect him as they are well aware of their dubious character. He said that the state government has adopted a zero tolerance policy against scams and extortion adding that law will take its own course in such cases and we will not buckle under any pressure.

Mann said that the incident of deporting of youth from the USA is an eye-opener for all of us that instead of going abroad in search of green pastures, the youth of the state must work hard here only and achieve success in various fields. He said that the state government is providing a number of opportunities for youth to excel in various arenas. Citing an example, he said that more than 51,000 youth have got government jobs in the state through hard work, dedication and commitment.

The Chief Minister said that there are examples where youth have got two to three jobs in the state during the last one year adding that due to this the trend of reverse migration has started as youth who had earlier settled abroad are now making a beeline to come and join the state government. He said that recently a couple has returned back from Canada to join government service here and many more such people have got the job here. Mann said that his government is offering the job to youth daily and they should take advantage of this situation and work here.

Replying to a query, the Chief Minister reiterated that the state government is fully with the Punjabis who have been recently deported from the USA. He said that the state government will provide them opportunities for rehabilitation so that they become active part-

## Himachal Pradesh govt amends prison rules, ends caste-based work allotment

PNS SHIMLA

The Himachal Pradesh government has amended all caste-based provisions in the HP Prison Manual 2021 to ensure equality and eliminate caste-based work allocation among prisoners, an official said on Saturday.

The state government has inserted a paragraph in the manual prohibiting caste-based discrimination in prisons and correctional institutions. The newly added provision (para 5.66) ensures that no discrimination, classification, or segregation of prisoners will occur on the basis of caste, a government spokesperson said. Further, para 5.67 mandates that there will be no discrimination of prisoners in the allotment of any duty or work in prisons on the basis of their caste, he added. Para 5.68 invokes the provision that prisoners will not be engaged in manual scavenging, sewer system maintenance, and septic tank cleaning. Earlier, a provision in the

Jail Manual allowed the employment of paid sweepers

in the absence of female prisoners for cleaning tasks. This clause, previously under paragraph 214, has now been completely deleted. The spokesperson said that jail records will no longer mention the caste, community, or religious affiliations of inmates of prisons. The state government has introduced these reforms through the Himachal Pradesh Prison Manual Second Amendment, 2025. Furthermore, the amended Jail Manual also provides a clear definition of habitual offenders. A person will be classified as a habitual offender if they have been convicted or sentenced to imprisonment on more than two occasions for The spokesperson said that

the government remains committed to upholding dignity, equality, and justice, ensuring fair and non-discriminatory prison operations in the state.



He chose to cut the policy repo rate to a historic low of 4 per cent, continuing with the lowinterest rate regime for almost two years to help the economy hit badly by the lockdown. ## Army to boost air defence with guns, radars

With drones and other disruptive technologies impacting the dynamics of warfare as demonstrated in recent conflicts, the Army Air Defence has drawn a roadmap to boost its capabilities through replacement of two of its old platforms, induction of new fragmentation ammunition for existing air defence guns, and deployment of more potent radars. Besides, the army is also hoping to

place a contract for the indigenously developed Quick Reaction Surface to Air Missile (QRSAM) system within 4-5 months, a top official said on Friday. The Corps of Army Air Defence holds a large variety of missile systems and guns in its inventory such as the L70, Zu-23mm, Schilka, Tanguska and Osa-AK missile "The fashion of guns is back. The army

sustained them for good reason and these guns can be effectively used with fragmentation ammunition," Director General of Army Air Defence (AAD), Lt Gen Sumer Ivan D'Cunha, said.

Asserting the need for modernisation with an emphasis on 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat', Lt Gen D'Cunha also cautioned that the Indian industry must offer "reduced timelines" when it comes to delivery.

need to carry out a cost-benefit analysis and it would be cost prohibitive to use missiles against all drones. So, fragmentation ammunition is the way forward," Lt Gen D'Cunha said.

The AAD is also in the process of acquiring radars such as the Low-

Level Light Weight (LLLR) radar. "We had bought LLLR radars as part of an emergency procurement which is capable of picking up Mavic drone without grenade, and can definitely pick up with grenade. Nano drones beyond this size may be able to carry out surveillance but can't carry weapons. So, we are looking at increasing the density of these radars," he said. Greater density is required for mountains and valley, the senior officer said.

Lt Gen D'Cunha also cited the Russia-Ukraine conflict and other recent conflicts to emphasise the importance and growing threat of drones, counter-drones and other disruptive technologies.

The employment of drones as a concept manifested in a different way in the Russia-Ukraine conflict. Both drones and counter-drone systems came up in a "big way", he said. The development of this capability

was so "escalatory in matrix" that every day there is new technology coming in, which becomes a challenge for air power, the AAD DG said. "Integrated with proper surveillance grid of radars, it ensured that Russian

started flying higher and their vulnerability increased. This has allowed Ukraine to maintain control over its airspace and support its ground forces more effectively," Lt Gen D'Cunha said

## Government to revise draft Advocates (Amendment) Bill PTI NEW DELHI

## Puri hints at reduced fuel prices, inflation

Union Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister Hardeep S Puri has said with more oil coming up in the global market including from the USA, energy prices are likely to come down which would help tame inflation.

Addressing a Press conference, exuding confidence that India has established contacts with the new US administration led by President Donald Trump, Puri said the Indo-American relationship on the energy front will deepen.

According to him India imports oil from as many as 40 countries, including Argentina and since there is enough oil in the world, even oil producing nations which are implementing cutbacks will be compelled to reconsider their decisions. He also said de-dollarisation of oil purchases was never the objective, emphasising that "most transactions are in dollars

"Inside the United States, he (Trump) said, 'Drill, baby, drill,' which is a signal to drill more

and always have been".

and extract more oil. He has been on record stating that he wants to bring international oil prices down," said the Oil Minister.

So, I think the global energy sit uation will improve. More energy will enter the market, and hopefully, that will help bring prices down. When energy is available in sufficient quantities at lower prices, it also helps in managing inflation," he further said.

He clarified that India's primary objective is to procure sufficient oil "at lower prices" to help control inflation.

De-dollarisation is not an objective at all. Most of these (oil) transactions are in dollars and always have been. We had one transaction in rupees, but I think it was a very small one. Transactions in rupees are a good thing, but it takes two to tango," Puri told reporters.

According to the Union Minister, India is already purchasing energy worth up to \$ 20 Billion from the US, emphasising that Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently had a very successful round of discussions with US President Donald Observing that there has never

been a shortage of energy in the global market, the former diplomat highlighted that more oil is entering global markets than ever before, especially from the Western Hemisphere.

"Brazil used to produce 3 Million barrels of crude per day. They (Brazil) have now started producing an additional 140,000 to 150,000 barrels per day. More oil is coming, much of it from Guyana, Suriname, and Canada. The United States is the world's largest producer of crude, at 13 Million barrels per day. I think they are going to produce 1.6 Million barrels more," he said. Likewise, he said Venezuelan oil will also flow into global markets as 'the situation' between the US and the Latin American country is easing.

President Trump, not only during his first tenure in office but also in the run-up to his second election, has been very clear that he wants to bring more energy into the global market, said Puri. Responding to questions about fuel costs, he said India is the only country where petrol prices have decreased in the past three years, citing excise tax cuts by the Centre in November 2021 and May 2022. 'And BJP-ruled states reduced

their VAT. Now, when it comes to benefits, governments don't benefit. First of all, governments don't import oil. It is private sector players or oil market-ing companies (OMCs) that import oil. And what does the government do with the revenue it collects? It provides 80 crore people with three meals of dry rations a day," he said.

According to Puri, petrol prices rose across several countries between February 2022 and February 2025-by approximately 48 per cent in Pakistan, 14.7 per cent in Bangladesh, 37 per cent in Sri Lanka, 16.2 per cent in Nepal, 14.2 per cent in the USA, 4.8 per cent in Italy, 4.2 per cent in Spain, 2 per cent in Germany, 4.2 per cent in France, while in India, they declined by 0.7 per cent.

The CAG's latest audit report Compensatory Afforestation Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) laid recently in Uttarakhand Assembly during its ongoing budget session said ₹ 13.86 Crore was diverted at the

There were instances of dys-functional bottom-up plan-ning and adoption of ad hoc or arbitrary approaches for the inclusion of irregular items in the Annual Plan of Operation

(APO). The release of funds was unrealistic and not commensurate with the approved APO. The state authority failed to ensure equitable and need-based funding of activities in all the implementing

agencies. There was inefficiency in funds release, not adopting of accounting procedure as per Compensatory Afforestation Fund rules, and not discharging of interest liability, the CAG report said. The CAG has recommended that the state authority must exercise internal control and institute proper budgetary control checks for robust financial management so that misutilisation or diversion of CAMPA funds can be pre-

# Hamas frees 6 more hostages

amas freed all six hostages in the latest exchange on Saturday, even as heightened tension between the adversaries clouded the future of the fragile ceasefire deal

The six included three Israeli men seized from the Nova music festival and another abducted while visiting his family in southern Israel when militants stormed across the border in the October 7, 2023, attacks that triggered Israel's nearly 16-month campaign in

the Gaza Strip. Two of the hostages had been held by Hamas for around a decade since they each entered Gaza on their own.

Five of the captives were handed over in staged ceremonies that the Red Cross and Israel have condemned in the past brought out by masked, armed Hamas fighters in front of hundreds of Palestinians before being transferred to Red Cross

In the central town of Nuseirat, Omer Wenkert, Omer Shem Tov, and Eliya Cohen were posed alongside Hamas fighters on the stage. A beaming Shem Tov even kissed two

The latest releases, to be followed by the freeing of hundreds of Palestinians impris-oned by Israel, went ahead after tensions mounted over a grisly and heart-wrenching dispute triggered this week when Hamas initially handed over the wrong body for Shiri Bibas, an Israeli mother of two young boys abducted by the militants. The remains that Hamas transferred with her sons' bodies on Thursday were later determined to be those of an unidentified Palestinian woman. In response, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu vowed revenge for "a cruel and malicious violation," while Hamas suggested it had been a mistake.

On Friday night, the small militant group believed to have been holding Bibas and her sons — the Palestinian Mujahedeen Brigades — handed over a second body. Bibas family said Israeli forensic authorities had confirmed the remains were hers.

"For 16 months we sought certainty, and now that it's here, it brings no comfort, though we hope it marks the beginning of closure," the family said.

## Difficult negotiations likely over ceasefire's next phase

The ceasefire deal has paused the war but is I nearing the end of its first phase. Negotiations over a second phase, in which Hamas would release dozens more hostages in exchange for a lasting ceasefire and an Israeli withdrawal, are likely to be even more difficult.

The six hostages being freed Saturday are the last living ones to be released under the first phase. Cohen, Shem Tov and Wenkert, all in their 20s, were abducted by Hamas fighters at the Nova music festival. During their release, they were brought out wearing fake army uniforms, though they were not soldiers when they were kidnapped.

Earlier Saturday, two other hostages — Tal Shoham, 40, and Avera Mengistu, 38 — were freed in the southern Gaza city of Rafah. Arriving back in Israel, both were taken to medical centres for examination.

This is an unforgettable moment, where all emotions are rapidly mixing together. Our Tal is with us," Shoham's family said in a statement, calling for a deal to free all those still captive. 'There is a window of opportunity; we must not

Shoham, who also holds Austrian citizenship, was visiting his family in Kibbutz Beeri when Hamas militants stormed into the community during the October 7, 2023 attacks. Shoham's wife, two young children, and three other relatives who were abducted with him were freed in a November 2023 exchange

Mengistu, an Ethiopian-Israeli, had been held in Gaza since entering on his own in 2014. ers, without providing evidence.

Watching the handover on Israeli media, Mengistu's family and friends broke out into a Hebrew song, "Here is the Light," as they saw him for the first time in more than a decade. "Do you remember me?" one of his brothers asks as they embraced at the hospital.

Hundreds of Palestinian prisoners set for release: Later Saturday, Israel is to release 620 imprisoned Palestinians.

They include 151 who were serving life or other sentences, around 100 of whom will be deported to other countries, according to the Palestinian prisoners media office.

They also include 445 men as well as 18 children between the ages of 15 and 17, five aged between 18-19, and a woman, all of whom were seized by Israeli troops in Gaza during the current war, according to the media office.

Hamas has said it will also release four more bodies next week, completing the first phase of the ceasefire. If that plan is carried out, Hamas would retain about 60 hostages, about half of whom are believed to be alive.

Hamas has said it won't release the remaining captives without a lasting ceasefire and a full Israeli withdrawal. Netanyahu, with the full backing of the Trump administration, says he's committed to destroying Hamas' military and governing capacities and returning all the hostages, goals widely seen as mutually exclusive.

Israel's military offensive killed more than 48,000 Palestinians, mostly women and children. according to Gaza's Health Ministry, which doesn't distinguish between civilians and combatants. Israel says it has killed more than 17,000 fight-

# Mallya pursues annulment of UK bankruptcy order

"From Dr Mallya's perspective, these English bankruptcy proceedings have an unreal quality," Leigh Crestohl, Managing Partner of Zaiwalla and Co-Mallya's recently appointed lawyers, told PTI. "Evidence has now come to light

## **Chinese virologists** warn of new **Covid-19 type virus**

Chinese team of virologists Ahave found a new bat coronavirus that carries the risk of animal-to-human transmission because it uses the same human receptor as the virus that causes Covid-19, a media report said.

The study was led by Shi Zhengli, Chinese virologist from the controversial Wuhan Institute of Virology (WIV), where the COVID-19 was alleged to have emanated from. Shi, who is known as the Bat Woman for her research on viruses from the Bats, as well as the Chinese government deny that the virus was leaked from the Wuhan lab.

The latest discovery is a new lineage of the HKU5 coronavirus first identified in the Japanese pipistrelle bat in Hong Kong. The new virus comes from the

merbecovirus subgenus, which also includes the virus that causes Middle East respiratory syndrome (Mers), the Hong Kong based South China Morning Post reported. The virus is able to bind to

the human angiotensin con-

same receptor used by the Sars-CoV-2 virus, which causes Covid-19, to infect cells. 'We report the discovery and

isolation of a distinct lineage (lineage 2) of HKU5-CoV, which can utilise not only bat ACE2 but also human ACE2 and various mammalian ACE2 orthologs [- genes found in different species with a common origin]," the team of virologists headed by Shi wrote in a paper published in the peer-reviewed journal Cell on Tuesday, according to the Post report. The researchers found that when the virus was isolated from bat samples it could infect human cells as well as artificially grown masses of cell or tissue that resembled miniaturised respiratory or intestinal

Earlier this month, China said its bio-lab in Wuhan which faced allegations leaking the COVD-19 causing the global pandemic has never engaged in "gain-of-function studies" on coronavirus amid allegations that USAID has funded the study of the infectious dis-

Brown's public support of Black Lives Matter after the police killing of George Floyd had made him fodder for the administration's wars against "wokeism" in the military.

The subcontinental rivals' last Champion Trophy clash was the 2017 final in which Pakistan walked away with the win and the trophy. Rizwan and Co would look to draw inspiration from that triumph in London but would also need to scale up their performance in every department.

Though the buzz surrounding the match is nowhere close to being what it used to be at the peak of diplomatic tensions between the two countries, there is an air of quiet
