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US SUPREME COURT PAVES WAY FOR EXTRADITION OF 26/11 ATTACKS MAST

n a major development, the US Supreme Court has paved the way for Pakistani-Canadian national and 26/11 attacks case accused Tahawwur Hussain Rana's extradition to India where he will face trial in the Mumbai terror strikes case. The US apex court early this week dismissed Rana's review petition (writ of 'certiorari') filed on November 13, 2024 challenging his extradition to India. With the rejection of his petition, Rana has exhausted all his legal options to evade his extradition to India. Now, Rana's extradition to India has become

imminent. In the past, Rana had lost similar pleas, both in US Court of Appeals in San Francisco and several federal courts, to be sent to India for prosecution of charges in the November 26-29, 2008 attacks case, in which 166 people were killed and 300 others injured

During the hearing in his latest plea in December 2024, the US Solicitor General

Elizabeth B. Prelogar had made a strong case for rejection of Rana's review petition on the ground that the Lashkar-E-Taiba (LeT) operative was not entitled for relief from extradition to India.

A former medical officer in the Pakistani army, Rana had migrated to Canada in 1990 where he became a citizen before moving to Chicago. As per US law, if he is not extradited to India, he will be deported to his home country Canada after the completion of his prison term in 2027. Rana is currently lodged in a Los Angeles

prison for his involvement in plotting a terror attack on the Danish newspaper Ivllands-Posten. Rana had contended that he was tried and

acquitted by a federal court in Illinois (Chicago) on the charges pertaining to the 26/11 case, for which India sought his extradition. However, Prelogar had strongly opposed Rana's plea. Rana is accused of significant involvement in the 26/11 attacks case.

Ajmal Kasab was among the ten Pakistani terrorists who had carried out brazen

attacks on Mumbai. While nine of the ten terrorists were killed by the security forces during the attack, the remaining one-Mohammed Ajmal Kasab - was caught alive by the police at Girgaum Chowpatty on the intervening night of November 26-27, 2008. After his conviction in the case, Kasab was hanged to death in the 26/11 attacks case in Pune's Yerwada central prison on November 21, 2012.

Rana is one of the two masterminds who are yet to be brought to justice, while the other is Sayed Zabiuddin Ansari alias Abu Jundal, an Indian operative who worked for the Lashkar terror group. He was arrested in 2012 after being identified by Kasab and is currently behind the bars in Mumbai.

Welcoming the impending extradition to India, senior advocate Ujjwal Nikam, who was the Special Public Prosecutor in the 26/11 attacks case, said: "This is major success for India because the Supreme Court of America has dismissed the review petition of Tahawwur Rana. Tahawwur Rana and David Headley are

the close links behind the terror attack of the 26/11 Mumbai attacks. By extraditing Tahawwur Rana, India will get more information and evidence of the involvement of some of the Pakistani people, including the Pakistan security apparatus. I am very optimistic that the extradition of Tahawwur Rana will give more evidence about the involvement of some of the security apparatus of Pakistan,

Rana is a close aide of the Pakistani-American terrorist David Coleman Headley, who was also wanted by India for the 26/11 hit, carried out by 10 heavily armed Pakistan terrorists.

In an amended criminal complaint in the Illinois court against Headley and his accomplice Tahawwur Hussain Rana, on October 21, 2009, the FBI had given details about the reconnaissance done by Headley in India and his links with Rahul Bhatt, whom he (Headley) had befriended during his trips to India. Bhatt and his fitness instructor friend Vilas Pandurang Varak had subsequently confirmed having

met Headley during his visits to India. It may be recalled that on September 26 2023, the Mumbai crime branch sleuths had filed a 405-page supplementary charge-sheet against Canadian businessman of Pakistani origin Dr. Tahawwur Hussain Rana based on fresh evidence against him.

Among other things, the supplementary charge-sheet had alleged that Rana had stayed in India for 11 days - from November 11, 2008 to November 22, 2008. Of these days, he spent two days in Mumbai, where he stayed at Hotel Renaissance at Powai.

In its charge-sheet submitted before the trial court, the crime branch police had added Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) section 39A (offence relating to support given to a terrorist organisation) against Rana in the case."We have gathered some fresh evidence against Rana in the form of statements and documents," a senior crime branch officer





Tight security arrangements in Punjab, Haryana in view of R-Day celebrations

head of the Republic Day Acelebrations on Sunday, security has been stepped up across Punjab, Haryana and the Union Territory of Chandigarh.

Security arrangements have been strengthened at vulnerable places and key installations, bus stands, railway stations and government build-ings at the district headquarters, officials said.

Security has also been strengthened in and around the venues where the Republic-Day celebrations will be held, including where top dignitaries will unfurl the tricolour.

Dog and bomb squad teams have been pressed into service to ensure fool-proof security in vulnerable places across Punjab and Haryana, the officials said. Checkpoints have been set up at several places across the two states and vehicles are being thoroughly

Punjab's Director General of Police (DGP) Gaurav Yadav had recently said the state police is fully prepared to ensure secure and peaceful Republic-Day celebrations and that security has been enhanced across the state. All the police officers were instructed to heighten security measures, increase patrolling and intensify night-domination operations, the DGP had said.

Punjab Governor Gulab Chand Kataria will unfurl the national flag at a state-level event on the occasion of Republic Day in Ludhiana, while Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann will hoist the flag in

Governor Harvana Bandaru Dattatreya will unfurl the tricolour in Faridabad, while Chief Minister Nayab

Singh Saini will do the same in Rewari.

The Haryana Police has also strengthened security measures across the state in the run-up to the Republic Day. Senior officers, including commissioners and district superintendents of police, have been directed to ensure an elaborate security cover at all important venues for the Republic-Day celebrations, officials said.


Police personnel are keeping a close vigil at sensitive locations to maintain law and order. A close vigil is also being kept at strategic locations, such as busy markets, bus stands and railway stations. Hotels, guesthouses, parking lots and restaurants are also being checked, the officials added.

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Focus on rectification of black spots to check road accidents in Pb

Punjab state road safety council and National Highway Authority of India organized a one-day workshop on the topic "Improvement of Black Spots and Their Impact on Road Accidents and Fatalities" to reduce road accidents and fatalities on Saturday. The focus was on improv-

ing accident-prone black spots and assessing their impact on road accidents and fatalities. Additional Chief Secretary of Transport, D.K. Tiwari commended the role of the Road Safety Force and encouraged officials from various departments to adopt well-coordinated measures to minimize road accidents, especially during foggy weather conditions, and to discourage underage

Director General of the Lead Agency for Road Safety, R. Venkata Ratnam, pointed out that the number of fatalities due to road accidents in the

state is alarmingly high, with 14 deaths occurring daily. He urged road-related agencies, including NHAI, PWD, Punjab Mandi Board, and the Local Government Department, to put in more efforts to rectify black spots on roads and properly evaluate their impact to reduce fatalities. He also directed police and transport department officials to strictly enforce traffic rules to prevent accidents and save lives. Furthermore, he emphasized the importance of accurately documenting road accident

data to facilitate better planning

and ensure optimal utilization

of government funds allocated

accident prevention. Additional Director General of Police (Traffic), A.S. Rai, highlighted the performance of the Road Safety Force and stated that due to the effective operations of the force over the past 11 months, there has been a significant decline in road accidents and fatalities in Punjab, which is a testament to the efforts of the current Punjab government.

Aleader from Haryana's Ambala was shot dead by armed assailantsin Naraingarh, police said on Saturday. BSP leader Harbilas Singh Rajjumajra was accompanied by two friends, Puneet and Gugal, when the attack occurred while they were in their car on Friday evening. Puneet also sustained bullet injuries. After the attack, they were rushed to PGIMER, Chandigarh where Harbilas succumbed to his injuries late at night while Puneet was stated to be out of danger. Police said the attackers have so far not been identified. Naraingarh SHO Lalit Kumar reached the crime spot to begin investigation. Superintendent of Police, Ambala, S S Bhoria said that a police team has been constituted to nab the assailants. Ambala-based BSP leaders have demanded that the police make all efforts to nab the accused at the earliest. Rajjumajra had unsuccessfully contested the assembly election from Naraingarh last year.







One woman killed as apartment building collapses in Turkiye Istanbul (PTI): Rescuers pulled the body of a 23-year-

old woman from under a collapsed apartment building in central Turkiye on Saturday, state-run media said, as efforts continued to find a final person, believed to be her husband. Three others were retrieved from the wreckage and being treated in a hospital, Anadolu Agency reported. The collapse comes amid renewed focus on building safety following the deaths of 78 people in a fire on Tuesday that ripped through a 12-story hotel at a ski resort in northwestern Turkiye Investigators are examining whether proper fire prevention measures were in place. Interior Minister Ali Yerlikaya said on Saturday that 79 people were registered as living in the four-story apartment block in the city of Konya, some 260 kilometers (160 miles) south of the capital Ankara. Earlier, Yerlikaya said the last two people remaining under the debris were Syrian nationals. He added that the cause of the building collapse was not immediately known. "If there is a fault, negligence or anything else, we will learn it together," he told journalists. TV images showed emergency workers sifting through a large pile of rubble Saturday morning following the building's collapse Friday evening. Anadolu Agency reported that four people were detained as part of the investigation. The second anniversary of an earthquake that hit southern Turkiye and north Syria, killing more than 59,000, is just two weeks away. The high death toll at the time was due in part to building safety regulations being ignored. In 2004, a 12-story apartment building collapsed in Konya, claiming the lives

of 92 people and injuring some 30 others. Structural

adison Keys of the United States upset two-time defending champion Aryna Sabalenka of Belarus 6-3, 2-6, 7-5 in the Australian Open final on Saturday night to collect her first Grand Slam title at age 29. By adding this win over the No. 1-Sabalenka to an elimination of No. 2 Iga Swiatek in the semifinals on Thursday saving a match point along the way — Keys is the first woman since Serena Williams in 2005 to defeat both of the WTA's top two

players at Melbourne Park. Keys, ranked 14th and seeded 19th, was playing in her second

major final after being the runner-up at the 2017 U.S. Open. She prevented Sabalenka from earning what would have been her third women's trophy in a row at the Australian Open — something last accomplished by Martina Hingis from 1997-99 — and her fourth major title overall.

When it ended, Keys covered her face with her hands, then raised

her husband, Bjorn Fratangelo – who has been her coach since 2023 — and other members of her team, before sitting on her sideline bench and laughing. Sabalenka chucked her racket

The other Indian members of the all-star XI were pace spearhead Jasprit Bumrah, who also featured in the ICC's Test Team of the Year, allrounder Hardik Pandya and left-arm seamer Arshdeep

The standout performers from other nations to make the line-up were Australian marauder Travis Head, England's Phil Salt, Pakistan's Nicholas Pooran, Zimbabwe's Sikandar Raza, Afghanistan's Rashid Khan, and Šri Lanka's Wanindu Hasaranga.

Rohit the Test captain and Test batter has been under considerable pressure in the past few months owing to a series of debacles for the team as well as him personally. But the 37-year-old's credentials in the shorter formats remain

In T20 Internationals, Rohit had an unforgettable 2024, both as a leader and a batter. The seasoned opener amassed 378 runs in 11 matches at an impressive average of 42.00 and a strike rate of over 160. Rohit played a pivotal role in India's triumphant T20 World Cup campaign in the USA and West Indies, with three half-centuries, including a

His lethal yorkers and impeccable control at the death overs played a pivotal role in India's success, and his performances earned him a nomination for the Sir Garfield Sobers Trophy as ICC Men's Cricketer of the Year. The winner of that honour will be unveiled in the next three days.

Young left-arm pacer Arshdeep Singh emerged as India's most prolific wickettaker in 2024, scalping 36 wickets in 18 matches at an average of 13.50.

Arshdeep's ability to swing the ball early and deliver pinpoint yorkers in the death overs made him indispensable to the Indian squad.

Arshdeep named ICC Men's T20I Cricketer of the Year

Indian left-arm seamer Arshdeep Singh was on Saturday crowned the ICC Men's T20I Cricketer of the Year 2024 for his influential role in the team's World Cup title triumph, which cemented his reputation as one of the leading short format bowlers. The 25-year-old took 36 wickets in 18 matches last

He was also named in the ICC T20I Team of the Year 2024 earlier in the day alongside Rohit Sharma, Jasprit Bumrah and Hardik Pandva.

In the T20 World Cup in the Americas, Arshdeep showcased his mastery in both powerplay and death bowling and ended the tournament as the joint highest wicket-taker alongside Afghanistan's Fazalhaq Farooqi with 17 scalps at an average of 12.64 across eight matches.

His standout performance was one of the major factors behind India's campaign culminating in a dramatic seven-run victory over South Africa in the final in Barbados.

Shailesh Lodha's theatre debut delivers humour, emotion and family chaos, says SAKSHI PRIYA



hen I first heard that Shailesh Lodha was making his debut on the theatre stage in Dad's Girlfriend, I was intrigued. The play *Dad's Girlfriend* turned out to be a delightful mix of humour, family dynamics and emotional complexity. *Lodha* plays *Animesh*, a successful author and professor who returns to his estranged daughter *Diya* and her husband *Kanav* after years of emotional distance. From the outset, it becomes evident that the story is not only about comedy but also about reconnecting, understanding, and navigating personal challenges within a family. Lodha brings a grounded yet comedic presence to Animesh, capturing his complexity with both humour and a hint of vulnerability. He's not just the larger-than-life character you might expect; there's a human side to him that makes his emotional journey relatable relatable

Kanav, played by Aman Bajpai, adds a refreshing comic energy to the stage. His character starts out trying to navigate the awkwardness of having his father-in-law around, and his reactions provide much of the laughter throughout the play. But

what stands out is how the character develops, revealing deeper layers of insecurity and emotional turmoil as the story progresses. Then there's *Avni*, a fan of *Animesh* played by *Megha Mathur*. She brings a surprising element to

the play, stirring emotions and creating a sense of jealousy and tension, especially between her and Diya, played by Anumeha Jain. Their interactions bring a mix of comedy and conflict, creating a dynamic that keeps the audience engaged. Under the direction of Atul Satya Koushik, Dad's

Jaideep Ahlawat returns to the world of *Paatal Lok* in a more sombre way, yet the season remains compelling, says **ABHI SINGHAL**





aking away all the popularity even in the pandemic era, *Pataal Lok* has shined with its first season making the audience giving a reaction of great, awesome and what not. The second season of *Sudip Sharma*'s *Paatal Lok*, a multilayered crime drama that builds upon its layered season is healt. This season takes predecessor is back. This season takes a more subdued and contemplative approach making its shape deeply into the human condition, the nature of violence, and the brittle links that bind individuals and communities together. All this is showcased in contrast to the first season's plot on caste class and corruntion plot on caste, class, and corruption.

Jonathan Thom, a well-known Nagaland leader, was shockingly assassinated in Delhi at the start of the story. His ruthless murder starts a series of events that jeopardise peace negotiations in Nagaland. Inspector *Hathi Ram Chaudhary*, played expertly by *Jaideep Ahlawat*, is drawn into a web of political plots and personal grudges as a result of the crime. In order to track down a strange women named Page Ligar down a strange woman named Rose Lizo (Merenla Imsong), whose existence connects several story threads, Hathi Ram and his former coworker Ansari (Ishwak

Singh) work to catch her. Paatal Lok Season 2 chooses a slow-burning plot that puts character development and emotional resonance first, in contrast to the previous season's relentless pacing and incisive societal satire. In addition to examining issues of


trauma, sorrow, and the cyclical nature of violence, Sharma's writing digs deeply into

the emotional lives of its protagonists. Hathi Ram Chaudhary remains the emotional core of the series. Jaideep Ahlawat delivers a powerhouse performance, portraying the world-weary performance, portraying the world-weary inspector with the same grit and vulnerability that made him a standout in the first season. This time, *Hathi Ram* is not just chasing criminals but grappling with his own insecurities as a father and a man. His interactions with *Ansari*, now a successful IPS officer, form one of the show's most poignant arcs with themes of fellowship, professional jealousy, and unspoken respect. unspoken respect.

Additionally, *Sharma* defies the standard police procedural rules. The genre gives depth and dignity to side characters, who are sometimes reduced to mere story gadgets. Every subplot enhances the overall story, from Rose's heartbreaking search for comfort to Meghna Barua's played by Tillotama Shome, battle to be accepted as an Assamese woman in a system that is controlled by men.

controlled by men.

Director Avinash Arun's cinematography captures the duality of Paatal Lok: the grimy chaos of Delhi and the landscapes of Nagaland. The visuals serve as more than just backdrops; they echo the themes of division and alienation that permeate the story. The action sequences are tightly choreographed serving only justice to the



story rather than overshadowing it.

The writing, too, deserves special mention for its ability to balance the personal and the political. While the first season was a hammer blow to societal structures, this season is more of a scalpel, dissecting issues like the migrant crisis, unemployment, and the fragile peace in conflict-ridden regions. Abhishek Banerjee, who played Hathoda Tyagi in a killer Season 1, has also written two episodes in the series.

The cast shines across the board. Ahlawat is, as expected, a tour de force, but it's the supporting cast that truly elevates this season. *Tillotama Shome* delivers a nuanced performance as Meghna, a character who challenges both societal and viewer biases. Merenla Imsong's Rose is hauntingly tragic, while Nagesh Kukunoor's turn as a shadowy bureaucrat adds a layer of intrigue.

Paatal Lok Season 2 is a long-form

narrative accomplishment. It may not have the same initial effect as the first season, but it makes up for it with a deeper, more but it makes up for it with a deeper, more complex examination of its subjects. Every character, no matter how small, feels real in *Sudip Sharma*'s world, and every violent act has significance and repercussions. The series offers a moving reflection on the human cost of cruelty and the fading prospect of forgiveness, and it requires patient but rewards it abundantly.

Ever since inception these clinics have witnessed a huge footfall indicating that every third person of the state has taken benefit from these clinics. **FREE POWER**

The state government had launched the guarantee to provide free power to the people in 2022 and since then 90% of the households in the state are getting free power and have got zero power bills. This has reduced a big burden on the pocket of the common man by saving a minimum Rs 35,000 annually for poor households. It is also a matter of immense pride and satisfaction that along with domestic consumers, the food growers of the country are also getting free and uninterrupted power in the state.

CANAL WATER

At the time when I had assumed the charge of office only 21% canal water was being used in the state for irrigation purposes. However, it is a matter of great pride and satisfaction that today 72% of the canal water is being used for irrigation purposes. This has ensured availability of canal water to farmers at the tail ends, who were deprived of this for decades. **MALWA CANAL**

For the first time in the postindependence era my government has started the work for construction of Malwa canal in the state and it is on record that none of the previous governments of the state had paid heed towards this necessity of the farmers of the state. Around 150 kilometre long this new canal will usher a new era of unprecedented progress and prosperity in the state especially in Malwa region. The state government will spend around Rs 2300 crore on this prestigious project that will cater to irrigational needs of nearly two lakh acres of fertile land of the state.

SARKAR TUHAADE DWAR

In a major citizen centric initiative, the state Government has launched a new scheme namely Door-Step Delivery of Services under "Bhagwant Mann Sarkar Tuhade Dwar" to provide services to the citizens at their door-step on demand. Under the scheme, 43 citizen services have been identified which constitute more than 99% of the daily administrative works of people.

Another scheme namely AAP ki Sarkar AAP De Dwar, under which camps are being held all over the State to provide services to the citizens in their village has been launched and lakhs of citizens visit the camps to take the benefit of the availability of services at their places of residence.

INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT

The state Government is committed to providing a boost to the investment and industrial infrastructure in the State. With its earnest efforts, my Government has roped in investment of more than Rs 85,000 Crores with the proposed employment of about 3.50 lakh by leading companies like Tata Steel, Sanatan Textiles and others, who are making a beeline to invest in the state. The state Government has also introduced Green stamp paper in the registration of sale deeds to ensure faster and smooth issuance of regulatory clearances to industry pro-

JOBS AND EMPLOYMENT

During the last financial year, my Government has given job/self employment facilities to 1,11,810

camps/ job fairs/self-employment camps. Continuing the endeavour of providing government jobs on merit to deserving candidates, my Government has ensured fairness in recruitment while also ensuring efficiency. Till now more than 50,000 govt jobs have been given so far to youth of the state which implies that on an average the state government has given 51 government jobs to the youth daily in the last around three years of its tenure.

ZERO TOLERANCE AGAINST CORRUPTION

As vowed while assuming charge of office, the Aam Aadmi Party Government in the state has continued drive to eradicate corruption at an increasing pace. The state government has introduced an anti corruption helpline number 9501200200 on which any person can lodge their complaint if anyone seeks bribe from them. In order to ensure transparent governance, my Government has adopted a Zero Tolerance Policy towards cor ruption and trap cases were registered by Punjab Vigilance Bureau against Gazetted Officers, Non-Gazetted Officers and private persons who were caught red handed while accepting illegal gratification.

FARISHTEY SCHEME

The state Government has notified the FARISHTEY scheme, in order to save the life of accident victims and encourage the general public for their hassle-free participation towards helping the accidental victims. The state Government will offer a financial reward of Rs. 2000 to commend their noble deeds. Apart from financial reward, a certificate will be issued to such persons and they have been provided immunity from legal complications and police inquiries.

LAW AND ORDER

Despite being a border state, Punjab has emerged as an Oasis of peace and progress in the country and Punjab Police has started various initiatives in the form of operation CASO in this regard. Launching of Anti Gangster Task Force (AGTF) and PGD Portal have also acted as a pivotal to check the crime in the state. AGTF has spearheaded dedicated operations against gangsters and criminals in the state and other parts of the country, leading to the arrest of several wanted gangsters and criminals and busting various modules along with gangster recovery of huge cache of arms and ammunition.

In order to enhance the manpower in the Police department for enhancing its efficiency, the state government has already decided to recruit 1800 Constables and 300 Sub Inspectors every year in Punjab cops. For these 2100 posts every year around 2.50 lakh candidates are expected to apply for these posts so all the aspirants will get involved in academics as well as in improving their physique for clearing the tests.

The state government has also decided to recruit 10,000 new cops in Punjab Police for which notification has already been issued. **ELIMINATION OF CONTRACTUAL**

It is a matter of immense pride and satisfaction that by eliminating the word contractual prefixed before the posts of employees the state government has regularized services of 12710 teachers by overcoming all the legal and administrative hiccups With the regularizing of services these teachers will get an annual increment of 5% in their salaries coupled with other benefits including holidays. This will ensure that these teachers become an active partner in socio- economic devel-

opment of the state.

Recognizing the immense contribution of jawans of Armed forces, Paramilitary forces, Police and even Agnivirs in safeguarding unity and integrity of the country, the state government gives financial assistance worth Rs 1 crore to the family in case the jawans attain martyrdom in line of duty. DSR TECHNIQUE

Along with this, the Punjab Government has appointed 11 prominent players of the State as Punjab Civil Services (PCS) and Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) officers in a historic step towards honouring their immense contribution and boosting the morale of sporting talent of the state.

The drugs are our biggest challenge which has become a curse for the state. For this, 1500 village level defence committees have been formed in the 6 border districts of Punjab with a view to halt the drugs and weapon smuggling from the international border with Pakistan. Apart from this, the Punjab Government has established a state of the art 'Sahayta Sewa Ikai' (SSU) in the Mohali based headquarters of the Anti Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) in an important initiative towards effectively tackling the drug scourge in the state. This unit possesses modern technique and the paraphernalia which would be effective in keeping vigil on drug smugglers and supply chains.

Although, Punjab is in the frontline ranks and is serving the country well but despite that the pollution and the paddy straw management is a big challenge for us. During this Kharif season, a

considerable reduction of 70 percent has been registered in the paddy straw burning incidents whereas 58 Compressed Biogas (CBG) projects have been accorded approval in the state for tackling the paddy straw burning problem. Out of these, 7 pro-

jects are operational. The inadequate management of water pollution, air pollution and industrial waste are posing grave implications for the environmental stability in the state. Here, I would like to make a special mention of the Buddha Nala which was a clean and life giving stream of water once but is now a victim of pollu-

tion and apathy. The resolution of these issues occupies primary importance not only from environmental point of view but is also significant when considered from the aspect of the health of the people and the future of the

coming generations.

As the Administrator of the UT Chandigarh, I am glad to inform that Chandigarh has a world class infrastructure pertaining to sports. Our efforts are focused in the direction of developing Chandigarh as a sports powerhouse of the country within one year and organize more & more National and International level tournaments in Chandigarh.


